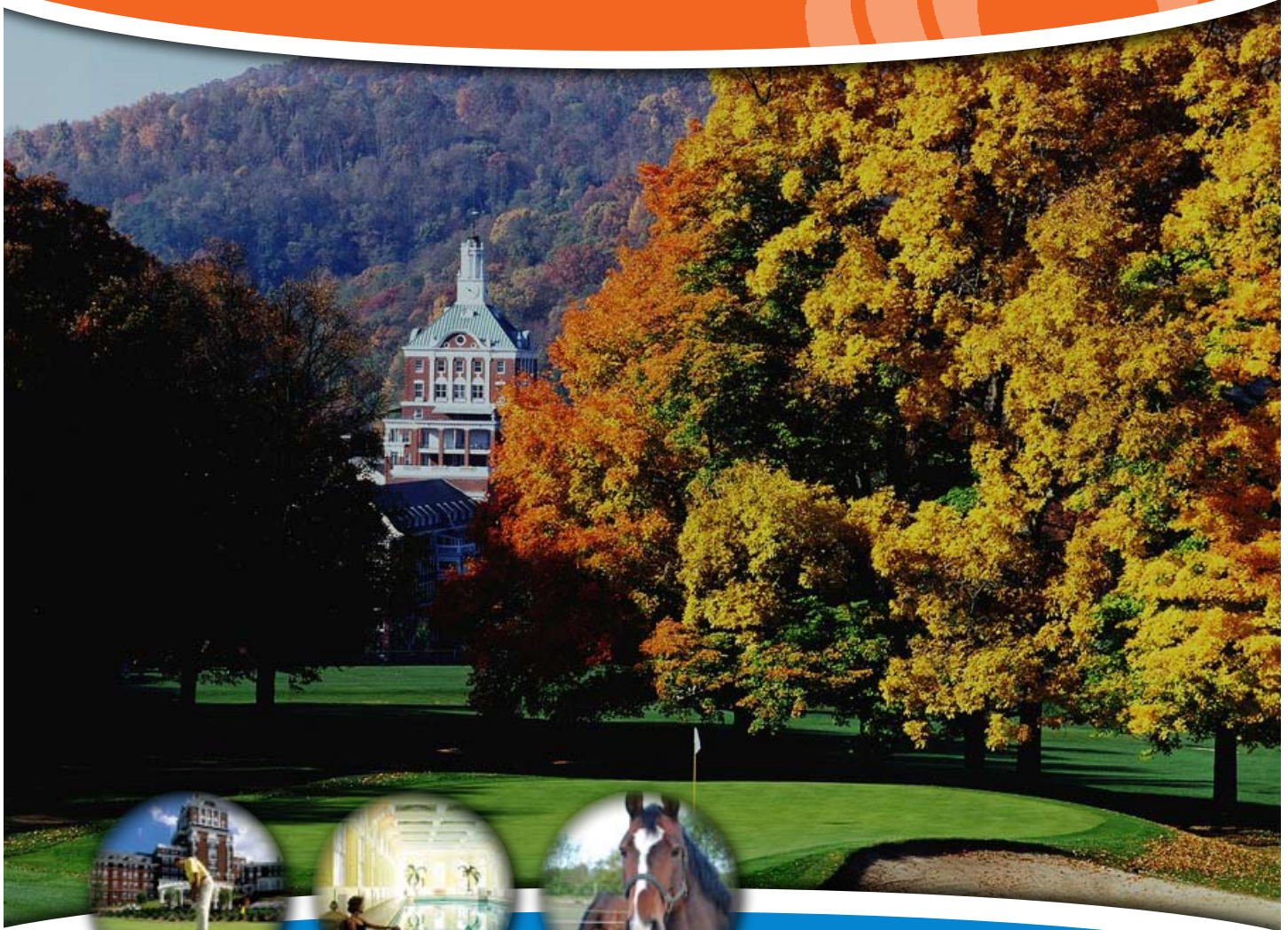

DIRECTIONS: Coming from points south, take Exit 150B off I-81 North (Troutville/US 220 North) and follow signs to I-64 west/Covington. Take Exit 16A off I-64 West to get on US 220 North and follow signs to the Homestead. Coming from points north and east, take Exit 220 off I-81 South onto Rt 262 North. Continue to Rt 254 west (the Parkersburg Pike Exit). This road becomes Rt 42 South, then Rt 39 and then US 220 South and follow signs to the Homestead.
